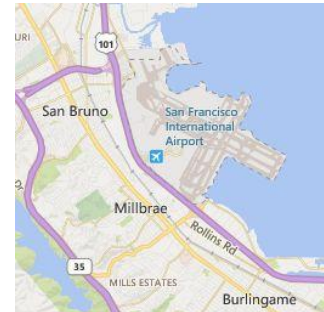
There will be a special Saturday Dinner and Lecture by author and physician, Jeffrey Lobosky on "The Affordable Care: Mission Accomplished?"

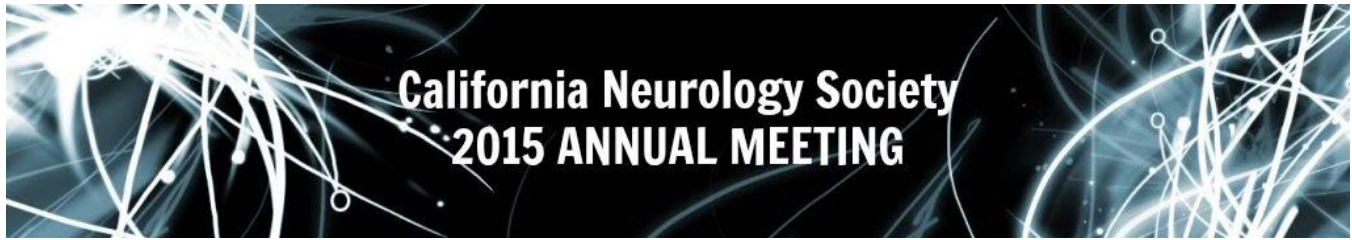
